**GENERAL RECRUITMENT (STATEWIDE)**

Applications are invited online only with photo uploaded from qualified candidates for appointment to the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service.

- 1 Department : Kerala Higher Secondary Education
- 2 Name of post : Higher Secondary School Teachers (Jr.)-Tamil
- 3 Scale of pay : ₹ 16180-29180
- 4 No. of vacancies : 4 (four)

The above Vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of the 3 years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the list. Subject to the availability of qualified candidates the number of candidates to be included in the Short list will be decided later by the Commission.

**Note:-** 3% of the vacancies are reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates as per GO (P) No.43/09/SWD dated 13.10.2009. PH belonging to the category of Orthopaedic (Lower Extremities), Blind, Low vision alone are eligible to apply under 3% reservation to PH candidates.

- 5 Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment.
- 6 Age : (1) 20-39 Only candidates born between 02.01.1972 and 01.01.1991 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual age relaxation to SC/ST Candidates and Other Back Ward Communities.

(For other conditions regarding the age relaxations please see para (2) of the General Conditions)

2) Relaxation in upper age limit upto 42 years as on the first day of January 2011 shall be allowed to the qualified Ministerial Staff under Higher Secondary Education Department for direct recruitment to HSST.

7 Qualifications:-

- I) Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any University in Kerala.
- II) 1) B.Ed in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala.

2) In the absence of persons with B.Ed Degree in the concerned subject. B.Ed degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.

3) In the absence of persons with B.Ed Degree as specified in items (1) and (2) above persons with B.Ed Degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent by any of the Universities in Kerala.

III) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the Agency authorized by the State Government.

Note:-

- 1) In the absence of B.Ed Degree holders, candidates having Masters Degree with not less than 50% marks and who have passed State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired PhD Degree or M.Phil Degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed Degree at their own expense within 5 years from the date of entry in service.
- 2) Those who have passed Language Teachers training Course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed qualification.
- 3) Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the subject concerned recognised by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.

Exemptions :

- 1) Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
- 2) Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
- 3) Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed Degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognised as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
- 4) The Teachers who have completed Ten years of approved teaching service at the Higher School level in the General Education Subordinate Service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.

#### 8 Mode of Submitting Applications:

The applications with latest photo uploaded shall be submitted On-line only. The photo uploaded should be that taken within six months and with name of candidate and date of photo printed on it. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. [www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form from the website shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

- 12 At the time of Examination, Physical Efficiency Test, Practical Test, Interview etc, Candidates shall produce their Photo affixed ID proof in Original and self attested photocopy of (Voters Identity Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Identity Cards issued by Social Welfare Department to Physically Handicapped Candidates, Photo affixed Pass Books issued by Nationalized Banks, PAN Card, Identity Cards issued to Government Employees by the concerned Departments) along with Hall Tickets.
